Welcome visitors! Please bring your current membership card to the work shop office and register as soon as possible after arriving. Club keys for the gate and facilities are available;

**Moorage:** (a) Reciprocal Club Member:

7 days maximum stay in one year, first two days free, \$1.00 per foot thereafter.  
(GST included)

**Power:** 30 amp service, \$4.00 per day (Including free moorage days). (GST included)

**Rules for Visitors:**

Fly your club burgee at all times.

All pets on leash; any "accidents" to be cleaned up by pet's owner.

Auxiliary power units on between 0800 and 2200 only.

No open fires or barbecues on the floats.

Use onboard holding tanks or Clubhouse toilets.

Check with office or Staff Captain if vessel is to be untended for more than one day.

Reciprocal guests are not allowed to use B.Y.C. outstations.

**Facilities for Visitors:**

Garbage bins are adjacent to the parking lot.

Telephones are on the floats and in the office. Local calls are free. (For long distance, use your charge card or reverse charges, please.)

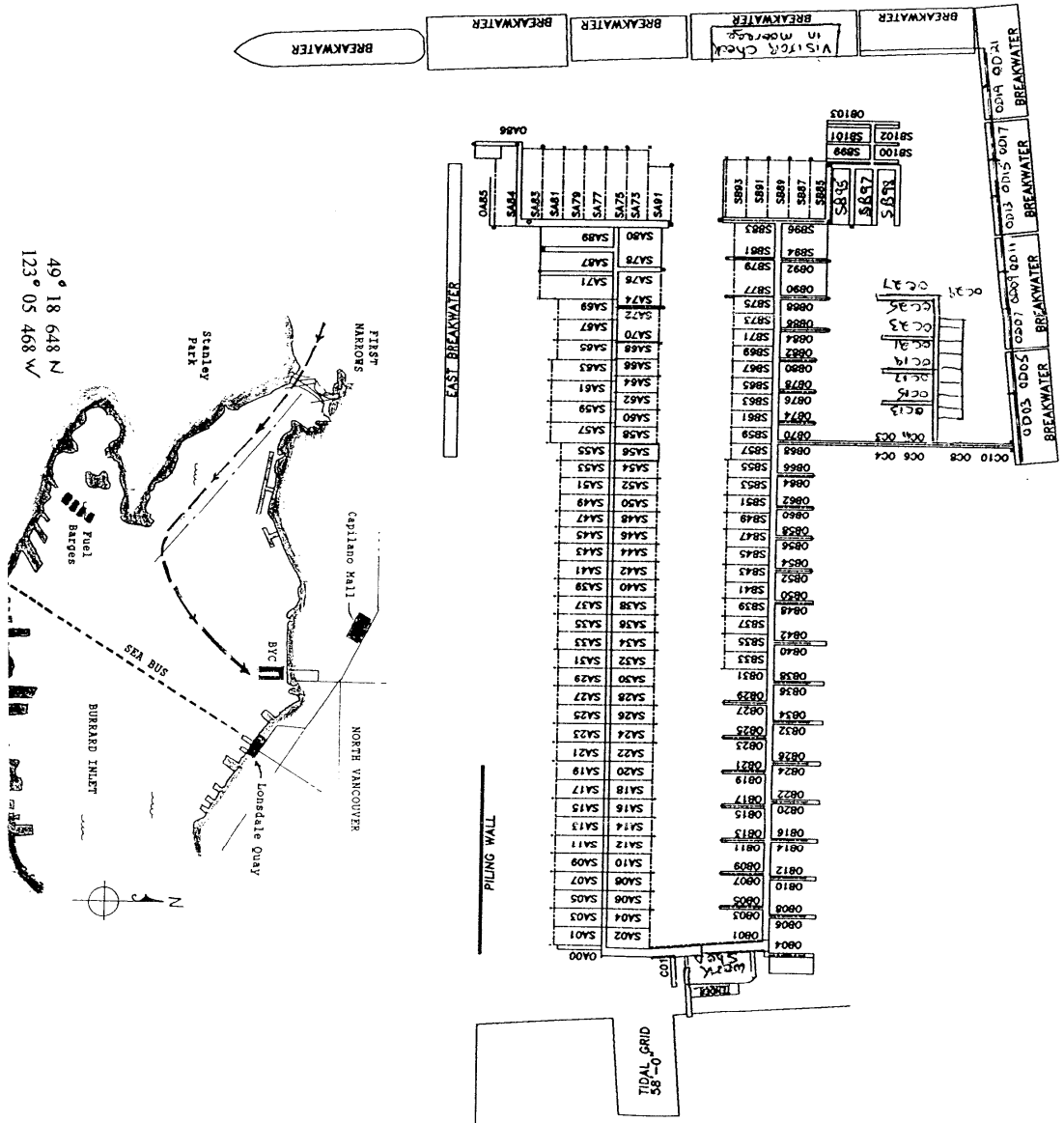
At the Clubhouse are toilets, showers, laundry and ice. Washrooms are also available on the floats (next to the workshop). A trading library is in the Crow's Nest above the work shop.

Within walking distance are restaurants, shopping malls, local busses and the Seabus to Vancouver.

Two major-brand fuel barges lie about 1 mile south of the Club at the entrance to Coal Harbour.
