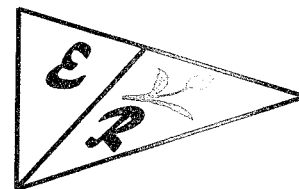

We are pleased to introduce our flag officers for 2008 and continue our agreement of reciprocal moorage privileges with your club. Our reciprocal moorage facilities are available at the Deception Pass Marina.

The Deception Pass Marina (formerly Cornet Bay Marina) N48°23.90' - W122°37.60' offers transient overnight moorage for small and large boats/yachts and can be accessed/hailed on VHF channel 16 or via phone on (360) 675-5411. Deception Pass Marina indents the north end of Whidbey Island off the southeast side of Deception pass and is a great place to visit as well as a great stopover for boats and yachts returning from the Strait of Juan De Fuca. The marina is unique in that it is a great place to duck into in case the Strait is too rough or if Deception Pass is moving too fast to exit to the strait.


- The marina has diesel, 92-octane gasoline, and propane
- Water and 30-amp shore power at the docks
- Provisioning supplies at reasonable prices
- Marine holding tank pump-out and Porta Potty dump on the dock
- Downtown Cornet Bay is 3 blocks away

Policy for use of facility

- Reciprocal moorage is available on a first-come first-served basis
- Limited to moorage only (electricity not included)
- 2 nights per year per boat
- Boats up to 45 feet
- Maximum of two boats per night per yacht club
- You must fly your yacht club burgee
- Pay your moorage
- Send receipt and a copy of your current yacht club membership card to ERYC at the address above

This reciprocal agreement remains in effect until revoked by either club.
