I.Y.C. of White Rock, B.C. wishes to continue to extend our reciprocal moorage privileges to your members, good "until rescinded" at Drayton Harbor, Blaine, Washington. One night complimentary moorage, with a maximum of two nights per year per boat, will be available for members of reciprocal clubs on a "first come" basis.

The entrance to the marina is marked by a red triangle to port. The sign also points the way to the transient float, the long float directly in front of the office. Contact the harbor office on VHF 68.

We request that you comply with the following:

- .Obey all posted rules
- .Clear customs (by pay phone) if entering from Canada
- .Register your reciprocal with I.Y.C. at the Harbor Master's office.

Marina facilities:

Power, fuel, gas, diesel, water, laundry, pump out, washrooms, showers and vessel repair facilities.

Blaine, Washington facilities (marina and town):

Chandlery, haul out, mechanical and electrical repairs, hardware, restaurants, bars, groceries.

For vessels returning to or entering Canada, customs clearance is available at the White Rock pier in Semiahmoo Bay.

If your cruising season plans include visiting this area, we would be pleased to have you enjoy our reciprocal arrangements.
