The 2010 officers and members of the Oak Harbor Yacht Club are pleased to continue to extend reciprocal privileges to your yacht club indefinitely or until revoked. Our current reciprocal moorage consists of two 40 foot slips, (slips #50 and #51 on F dock) at the Oak Harbor Marina. These slips will be available from May 1st thru September 15th. When arriving please check in with the Marina and pay only for your electrical service. From September 16th to May 1st we will continue to furnish two 40 foot reciprocal slips to the first two reciprocal boats of the day in any 40 foot slip in the guest moorage on a reimbursement basis; during this time period we ask that you check into the marina office, pay for your slip and electricity, then send us (or bring to the Club) your marina receipt and we'll reimburse you. In either case the reciprocal stay will be limited to two nights per month per boat and excludes electricity. We look forward to seeing you when next you're in the area.

The Oak Harbor Yacht Club bar and lounge continue to be open Wednesday thru Saturday evenings. The hours are posted at the club house. Please also check at the club house for special events.

Remember, when approaching Oak Harbor, northwest of the #2 red buoy are several rocks that are covered at high tide. Don't cut the buoy short. The approach to Oak Harbor is well marked but stay in the channel. When approaching after dark use caution. Some of the markers are not illuminated and the background city lights may confuse the first time visitor.
