  - \$3.00 per day for power
  - \$1.00 per bag for ice
  - \$1.00 per shower



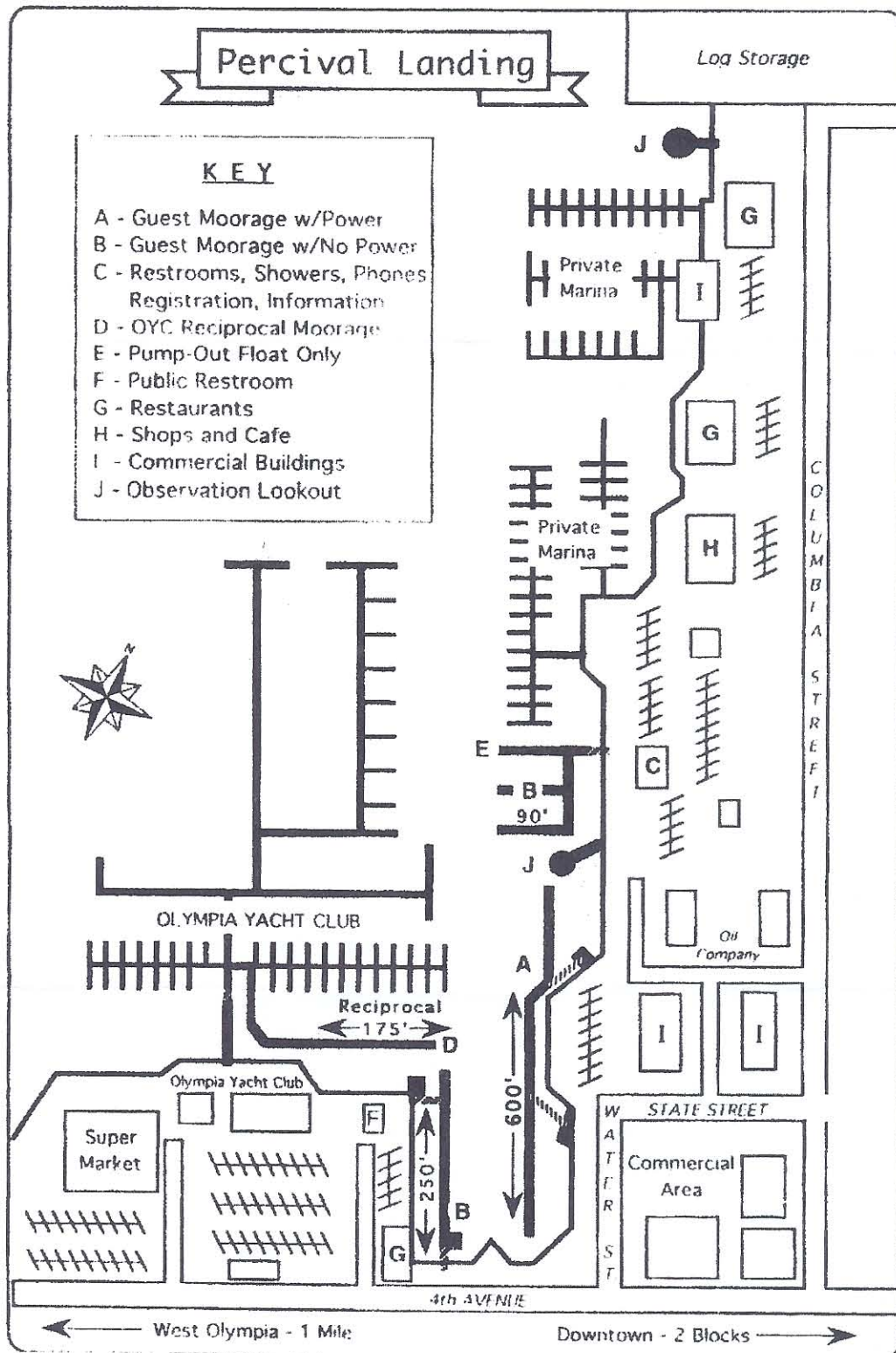
