# **PORT LUDLOW YACHT CLUB**

## **VISITOR MOORAGE REGULATIONS 2010**

WELCOME! The Port Ludlow Yacht Club leases **80 feet** of dock space on the inside of the first float at the East End of the Port Ludlow Marina for reciprocal yacht club guests. These facilities will be available from January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010. Upon arrival in Port Ludlow, please contact the Marina office, (360) 437-0513 or VHF Ch. 16/68, and you will be assigned a reciprocal slip if space is available.

Visiting skippers in good standing in a yacht club, in which we have reciprocal moorage arrangements, are allowed, if space permits, 48 hours free moorage **in a 30-day period** with a cumulative annual limit of five days.

Skippers must **present their membership card** and sign in at the Marina office upon arrival. After a period of 48 hours, if the skipper wishes to stay longer, he may arrange with the Marina office for a marina slip and purchase electrical service or anchor out in our well-protected Port Ludlow Bay. There is dinghy-landing space at the dock by the Marina office.

Visiting boats utilizing our guest moorage shall not exceed a total of **60 feet** in length and **must fly their club burgee**. Space is available on a first-come, first-served basis. **No space can be reserved**. Vessels should be closely spaced on the dock to maximize the use of our limited moorage.

Free showers, toilet facilities, laundry facilities, book exchange and a well-stocked store are available at the Marina office building. The Inn at Port Ludlow's Fireside Room is nearby for fine dining.

Port Ludlow Yacht Club's new facility, the "Wreck Room" is now open and available for use by your club's members. Please check our website ([www.plyc.us](http://www.plyc.us) & click Wreck Room link on left) for updated hours of operation, services available and contact information.

Open fires and use of barbecues in the Marina require special permission of the Marina staff.

Dogs are required to be on a leash at all times and owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.

As all skippers know, federal law prohibits throwing, discharging, or depositing any refuse matter of any kind into the water. The pump-out station located at the Marina fuel dock may be used at no charge.

By occupying our visitor moorage, the owner and/or skipper, crew, and guest covenant to, and hereby do indemnify and hold harmless, the Port Ludlow Yacht Club, and the Port Ludlow Marina from any and all loss, cost, charge, or expense, and any legal liability which may arise from, or in connection with, the use of the assigned moorage space including, but without limitation thereby, any claims of personal injury or property damage.

Port Ludlow Yacht Club is proud to announce the opening of its new facility, the Wreck Room. Located on the site of the old Harbormaster restaurant at the Port Ludlow Marina, the Port Ludlow Yacht Club's Wreck Room now offers reciprocal visitors a location to enjoy after-cruising drinks and fellowship as well as a pleasant location for cruising yacht clubs to meet.

We opened in the first quarter of 2010 with limited services as we plan for more amenities including BBQs, a large-screen TV, and more.
