A layout drawing of our facility, indicating the location of our reciprocal moorage, is enclosed. Your existing reciprocal courtesy card is **valid until revoked**.

Location: The POYC Yacht Basin lies on the south side of the westerly Puget Sound waterway known as Sinclair Inlet, across from the Bremerton Naval Shipyard, coordinates 47° 32' 25" N, 112° 38' 45" West.

Check In: There is 388 feet of reciprocal guest dock available to your members for their overnight convenience, group visit, or special event cruise-in. When that first-priority dock is filled, we can accommodate overflow in vacant member slips and other areas by assignment only. The guest dock is located along the outside of the Yacht Club's northern float (breakwater), and is indicated by yellow signs. The Registration/Gate Card Box is located on "M" Dock, just north of the main brow. After securing your vessel, please contact any of the POYC members listed in the registration box area for assistance in obtaining a gate key card. Please fly your burgee at all times.

Facilities: Berth sizes are undefined and are available on a first come basis. It is wise to call ahead to verify that moorage will be available, as we host group cruise-ins throughout the year. Reservations are required for special event group cruise-ins. Contact one of the officers listed above, or leave a message on our office phone, (360) 876-9010. 30 amp dockside power is available (\$3 per day), as well as water, garbage, pump-out, restrooms, shower, telephone, and ice. A fine dining restaurant and lounge is found a short walk from the Club. Explore downtown Port Orchard, offering colorful antique and gift shops, more restaurants, cocktails, entertainment, espresso, and microbrewery pub. POYC Marina is flanked by two full-service marine repair facilities, and marine stores and fuel are nearby. Our clubhouse is available free of charge for your cruising event, by special arrangement, to those clubs who offer a similar facility's use to POYC. Please feel free to join us during any Club activities or functions.

Lay Days: The first three days of each stay is free. Additional days must have an officers permission, and a \$5 per day fee will apply. A total of 14 days may be used in any calendar year. The POYC boating family looks forward to your visit. Please visit our website at www.POYC.org.

RECIPROCAL POLICY

1. POYC offers bonafide yacht clubs and boating organizations a like-kind agreement to reciprocate, i.e., clubs offering POYC members free moorage will receive free moorage from POYC at our private Port Orchard facility. Our clubhouse and Sweany's Place is also available free of charge with a Board-approved reservation. Our conditions are that the applying club offers similar facilities to POYC, free of charge. Our clubhouse may also available for rent to those clubs without such facilities to offer, and the Board may be open to negotiation if optional perks can be arranged.
2. Please fly your burgee at all times while visiting our Club and be prepared to show your membership card for the reciprocating club.
3. Pets must always be kept on a leash, and you are expected to clean up after them.
4. No open fires on the docks. You may make arrangements to use our covered barbecue area.
5. Visiting boats are moored on the outside of the Club breakwater. Only a POYC Club officer or event dockmaster can grant permission for use of vacant member's slips or other areas, unless prior arrangements have been made. POYC has no resident manager, but a telephone list is located on the main dock. Of course, in case of impending storm, protected moorage will be arranged for you. In this instance, or in case of emergency, any member can assist you.
