## TWO SLIPS AVAILABLE

1. Slip #281 on "D" Dock for boats up to 45 feet – All year long.
2. Second slip available June through August. Please check with the Moorage Office for its location and availability.

ALL VESSELS MUST REGISTER WITH THE PORT***

## INSTRUCTIONS & INFORMATION

- A. Advance reservations are not possible.
- B. **Check In** on Channel 09 or at Port Moorage Registration Office (360)385-2355 for reciprocal assignment before proceeding to slip.
- C. Please sign PTYC guest book located inside small dock stand at slip #281.
- D. Please fly your Burgee while in our slip.
- E. Due to the large volume of boat traffic heading both North and South and stopping in Port Townsend, we must limit our free moorage to:
  - a. **One night only** during the summer months (May 1 – Sept. 30)
  - b. **One night per month** during the "off season" (Oct. 1 – April 30).
 After one night, please ask the Port Moorage Registration Office for assignment to another slip. (**In no case, shall a boat stay two consecutive nights.**)
- F. 30 amp power is available for \$3.00 per night. The fee is paid to the Port at registration.
- G. Water is available at the float
- H. Restrooms, showers and phones are located near the docks.
- I. Pumpout stations are located at the fuel dock and at the far end of the marina.
- J. Please observe all rules & regulations as posted or required by the Port of Port Townsend.
