## POULSBO YACHT CLUB RECIPROCAL MOORAGE INFORMATION

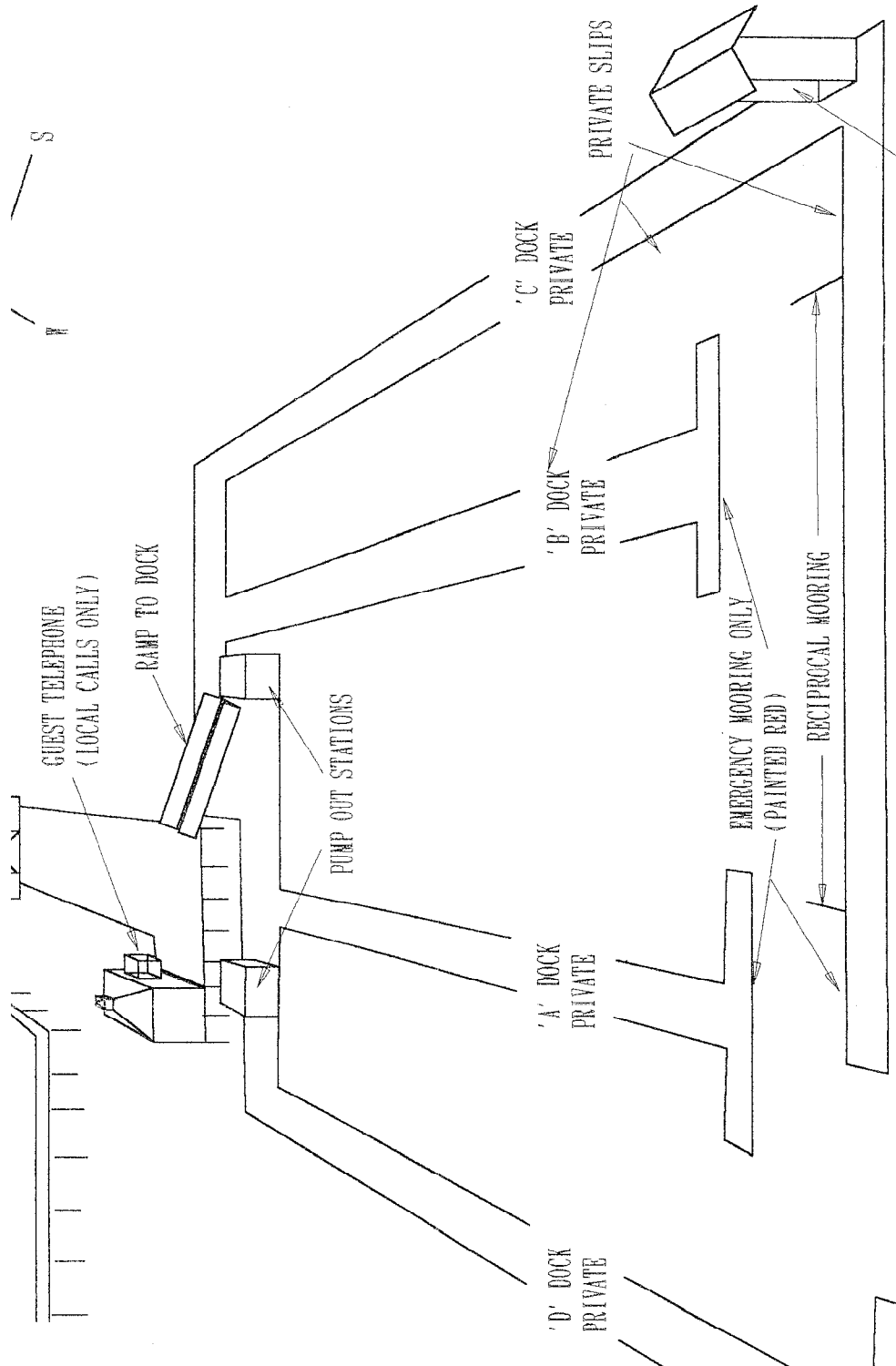
- Location : Second marina on your starboard side as you enter Liberty Bay  
Latitude: 47° 43.6 North Longitude: 122° 38.3 West
- Reciprocity : All year
- Available Moorage : 225', on inside of the breakwater. Only for Washington boaters whose YC name appears on PYC current Reciprocal Moorage List
- Reservation Policy : On a first-come first-served basis only
- Duration of stay : Limited to 48 hrs. Stays further limited by two (2) 48-hour periods per yacht per calendar quarter. To accommodate as many visiting yachts as possible, the two 48 hr visits must be interrupted by a minimum of 48 hrs.
- Registration : At guest kiosk. By registering, you agree to abide by the rules herein contained. Violation of these rules will be reported, in writing, to the commodore of your yacht club.
- Power : Outlet= 30 amps, Power Charges= \$3.00 per day
- Recip. Facilities : Entrance card: At kiosk (Please take only one card per vessel)  
Washrooms & Showers: In reciprocal areas of the clubhouse  
Washers & Dryers: In reciprocal areas of the clubhouse \$1.00 charge each washing & drying
- Garbage : Dispose of at north end of the parking lot inside the fenced (wooden) area
- Ice : At clubhouse reciprocal area, \$1.00 per bag
- Dock Carts : At the head of dock
- Pumpout Facilities : On dock directly below ramp. Also at Port of Poulsbo
- Shops, Restaurants : Downtown Poulsbo, about 3 blocks from clubhouse
- Fuel : At the Port of Poulsbo, about 1/3 mile north of our marina

### Courtesies

In consideration of PYC marina residents, and other guests, please observe the following:

- No loud music or other intrusive disturbances at any time
- Auxiliary power units may be used between 0800 and 2200 hours only.
- Skateboards, bicycles and mopeds are not to be ridden on the docks.
- Running, water-skiing, diving, open fires and other potential hazardous activities are prohibited in the marina.
- Barbeque devices are not allowed on PYC marina docks. Please keep them aboard your yacht.
- Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.
- Dogs must not be left unattended if barking is a problem.
- Sanding, painting, varnishing and other maintenance activities are not allowed on the PYC reciprocal dock.
- Use springlines to pull forward to the next boat, allowing room for another guest yacht to moor behind you.

*Guest's mooring privileges are at the guest's risk and neither the Poulsbo Yacht Club nor its members shall be held liable for any loss or damage while guests are moored at PYC. In the event of an emergency, PYC reserves the right to move or remove any vessel without liability to the Poulsbo Yacht Club.*
