We are pleased to extend to the Fidalgo Yacht Club officers and members reciprocal moorage privileges "valid until revoked" at our Club's moorage facilities located at the Port of Bremerton Marina.

We provide 80 feet of complimentary moorage space per night to Reciprocal Club members. This offering is limited to 2 boats at a time, 2 nights in any 7 consecutive day period per vessel and 2 nights per vessel per month. Power and extras not included. The Harbormaster will collect for power and any extras. The Marina can accommodate up to 100 foot vessels. Restrooms, showers, and laundry facilities are adjacent to the Harbormaster's office. Restaurants, visitor attractions, and buses are in close proximity along with the ferry terminal to Seattle and Port Orchard.
