### RECIPROCAL INFORMATION – WELCOME!

#### Club House

SJIYC is located at the northeast end of Front Street just above the U.S. Customs office at the head of “E” dock in the Port of Friday Harbor. The clubhouse is open whenever our burgee is flying from the flagpole at the south end of the clubhouse. Hours of operation are seasonally adjusted, and are posted on the bulletin board at the front door. We have a bar, lounge, restaurant facilities, restrooms and showers when the clubhouse is open.

#### Moorage

SJIYC reciprocal moorage is located at the end of “F” dock, at the Port of Friday Harbor, immediately inside the northwest entrance to the docks. Look for our burgee/logo and signs. We have 80 lineal feet of dock space available on a first-come, first-serve basis; unfortunately, we cannot take reservations. The first 24 hours are free if you are flying your reciprocal burgee. Rafting is encouraged. Please have your current yacht club membership card available upon checking in with the Port office at the head of the main dock.

#### Dockside Amenities

##### Water

Electricity 120v 30amp power (charges for electricity paid at the Port office)

Fuel – Texaco dock

Garbage facilities located at the head of Main dock

Block ice at the end of the fuel dock by the little storage shed

Propane at the fuel dock

Showers/restrooms located at the head of the main dock

#### Supplies/Facilities in Town

Grocery store, hardware store (which also has propane), and marine stores are all just a short walk from the docks.

Sail-In Laundromat – located on “A” Street just up from the ferry

Sunshine Coin-Op Laundromat – located on Nichols Street in the alley behind Bella Luna Restaurant

#### Town Amenities

There are many fine restaurants within walking distance. Also, several gift stores and antique shops are available for your browsing just a short walk from the docks.

#### Touring

Island Scooters and Bike Rental – 360-378-8811

Next to the ferry dock - offering both scooters and bicycles.

San Juan Trash – 360-378-8887

Bus, taxi, and tour service for San Juan Island and Orcas Island.

San Juan Limousine – 360-378-6777

San Juan Limo offers different ways to get around the island: vans, limo, and sedans.

#### Rules

Reciprocal guests are required to fly their yacht club burgee while moored at the SJIYC dock. Your current yacht club membership card is required to gain entrance to the SJIYC clubhouse. Reciprocal club members and their guests are welcome when the clubhouse is open with the exception of certain function nights. The reciprocal club member must accompany their guests on the SJIYC premises. No one under age 21 is allowed in the lounge/bar area.

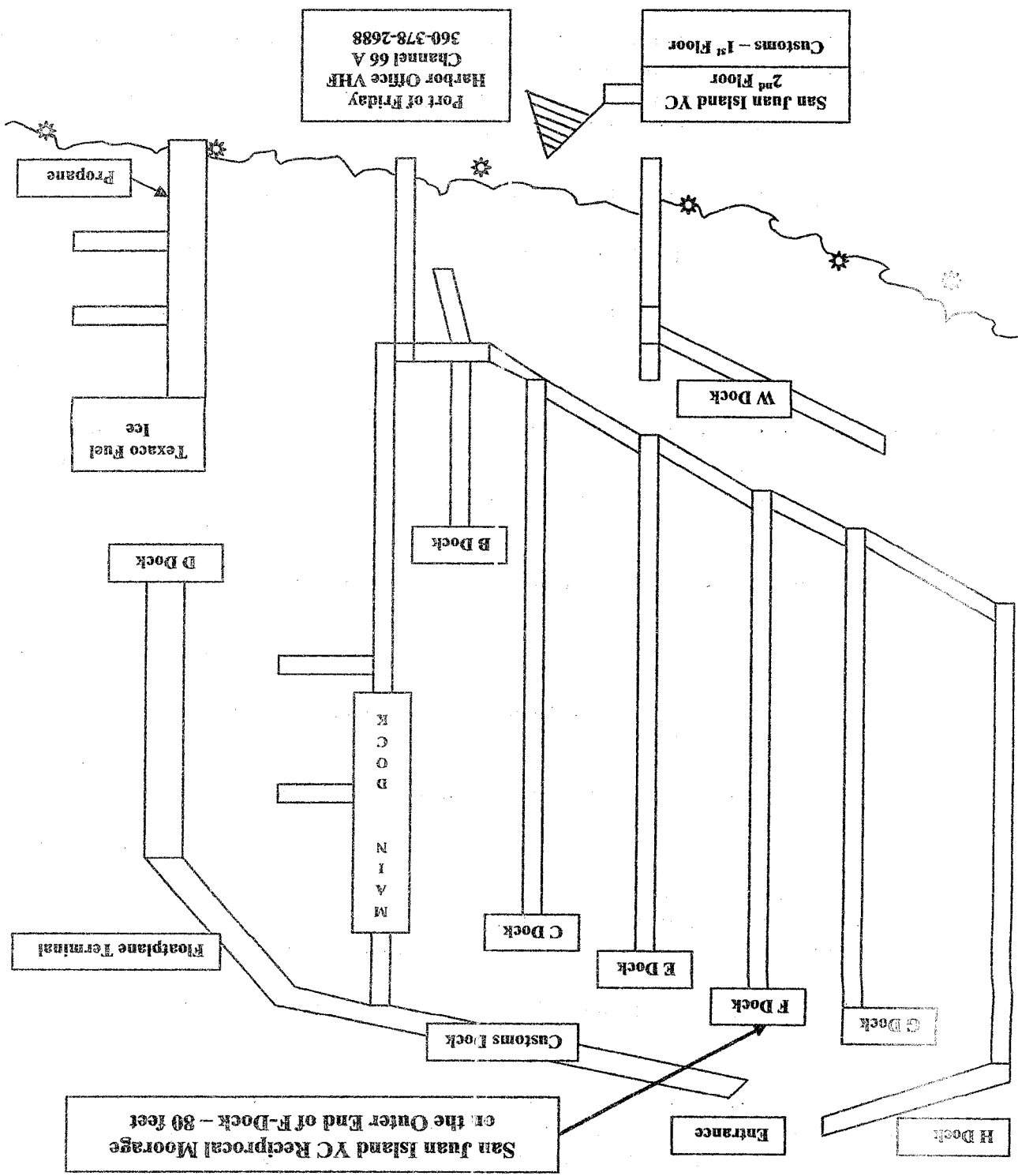
Welcome and thank you for staying at the San Juan Island reciprocal dock.

Because the San Juan Islands is a worldwide destination, we ask that you adhere to the following policies during your stay:

1. Please check in with the Port of Friday Harbor's Harbormaster immediately upon your arrival. At that time you must show a valid yacht club membership card from a club with reciprocal privileges of the San Juan Island Yacht Club. We update this list several times a year. If your club is not on this list, please contact your yacht club and request that they begin proceedings to request reciprocity.
2. You are allowed to stay a maximum of two consecutive nights. The first night is free except for power and water (which is paid to the Port of Friday Harbor) and the second night is assessed at the standard Port rate.
3. We allow rafting up to three boats deep. Rafting is not optional, it is mandatory. You must be willing to allow others to raft up to you.
4. Your stay is limited to two nights during any 30-day period.
5. Please feel free to come to our clubhouse and join us for dinner whenever you see the burgee flying.
